About the Club

Heyside Juniors, we were formed in 1975. We are run under the Heyside FC Constitution, running rules and Code of conduct which can be viewed online at www.heydefc.co.uk. We are England Football Accredited and have the highest recognition as a 3 star club.

- Shin pads, football boots and suitable clothing for weather conditions must be worn at training and match days. Each team has at least one person who has completed the FA Introduction to First Aid in Football.
- All Coaches are DBS(CRB) checked and required to pass an FA Introduction to Coaching Football qualification within 6 months of joining the club. The Coaches must also have completed Safeguarding Children Workshop or Player Welfare in Open Age Football.
- **Club Subs and fees**
 - Juniors and Angels sign on fee is £25 per season and £25 per month.
 - Open Age sign on fee is £25 per season and £20 per month.
 - Vets sign on fee is £25 per season and £15 per month.
 - All Signing on fees include player Personal Accident Insurance.

If you know of anybody who may wish to sponsor a Heyside FC team please advise, all sponsors will be promoted via the Heyside website, www.heydefc.co.uk, Social Media channels including Facebook and Instagram and displayed on players kits every week at each game.

Club Membership Agreement

I enclose **£25** as a membership fee to be repayable if this application is not successful. I consent to disclosure by Manchester County Football Association. This is due on 1st June each year.

1. All subs to be paid by standing order into the Heyside Bank Account, all payments must be paid in the first seven days of the month. If any player/parent goes more than two months overdue on subs payments, they will not be allowed to train or play until they have been brought back up to date.
2. If a player is injured or has an illness, then a copy of a doctor's note must be provided, and subs will be suspended by the club. Please note this is not at the managers discretion and the club must be notified immediately as to those eligible for subs suspension.
3. If a player wishes to transfer to another club, they will need to get written permission from the club to transfer. The player must be up to date with all subs payments until the date of transfer.
4. All Training and Matchday kit supplied remains the property of Heyside FC and must be returned to the club should a player leave.
5. All Kit must be returned in good condition. If not returned the club will invoice the player/parent to the value of the full kit price up to 12 months old, 50% of the price if 12-24 months old and 25% if over 24 months old.
6. If the player is under the age of 18 Parents/Guardians will be liable and responsible for any registration and monthly subs payments owed as well as any fines that may occur throughout the season, such as yellow and red cards.
7. All players must show RESPECT to fellow players, parents, managers, club officials, referees and members of any other club. Any breach of this will be deemed as club misconduct and may lead to the player being asked to leave the club with immediate effect.

By signing this agreement, you are confirming that you fully understand all points.

- If my son/daughter is injured whilst playing/travelling to or from football events for Heyside teams and I cannot be contacted on the above number, I hereby give my consent for my child to receive medical attention.
