About the Club

Heyside Juniors were formed in 1975. We are run under the Heyside FC Constitution, running rules and Code of conduct which can be viewed online at www.heysidefc.co.uk. We are an F.A. Charter Standard Community Club.

- Shin pads, football boots and suitable clothing for weather conditions must be worn at Academy training. Each team has at least one person who is qualified to administer emergency first aid.
- All Coaches are DBS(CRB) checked and required to pass FA Level 1 Coaching certification within 6 months of joining the club.

Club Subs and fees

- Academy players Age 6 and under can sign on from just £25 and then £14 per month
- o Signing on fee includes player personal protection insurance and a training kit is provided

Club Membership Agreement

I enclose £25 as a membership fee to be repayable if this application is not successful. I consent to disclosure by County Football Association.

- 1. All subs to be paid by standing order into the Heyside Bank Account, all payments must be paid in the first seven days of the month. If any player/parent goes more than two months overdue on subs payments, they will not be allowed to train or play until they have been brought back up to date. Failure to bring account up to date will result in the player leaving the club with immediate effect.
- 2. If a player is injured or has an illness, then a copy of a doctor's note must be provided, and subs will be suspended by the club. Please note this is not at the managers discretion and the club must be notified immediately as to those eligible for subs suspension.
- 3. Due to an extensive waiting list, any player who misses 3 consecutive weeks of academy training without a valid reason or prior notification will lose their place within the academy.
- 4. All Training and Matchday kit supplied remains the property of Heyside FC and must be returned to the club should a player leave.
- 5. If the player is under the age of 18 Parents/Guardians will be liable and responsible for any registration and monthly subs payments owed.
- 6. All players must show RESPECT to fellow players, parents, managers, club officials. Any breach of this will be deemed as club misconduct and may lead to the player being asked to leave the club with immediate effect.
